Protect your family pet Neighborhood canvassers to license Kenmore pets starting in June

King County Animal Services will be visiting homes in Kenmore starting this month to ensure your family's cats and dogs are protected with pet licenses. Pet licensing can save a beloved family member from being hurt or lost permanently. Last year, Animal Services reunited almost 1,700 lost dogs and cats with their owners with the help of a King County pet license.



King County Animal Services is working hard to license and protect pets. Through the Pet Partnership program, pet-licensing canvassers go door-to-door in most areas of the county to renew or license new pets.

The price of a King County pet license is \$20 for a spayed or neutered dog or cat and \$60 for an unaltered pet. Licenses are good for one year and must be renewed annually. A juvenile license for a puppy or kitten less than six months of age is \$5, and lasts six months. Senior citizens can purchase a discounted license valid for the lifetime of their neutered pet while it is in their possession (\$20 for dogs and \$12 for cats).

Canvassing door-to-door hours are: Saturdays from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m., Sundays from 11 a.m. to 6 p.m., and Monday through Wednesday from noon to 8:30 p.m.

Canvassers are King County employees and wear official photo identification, royal blue polo shirts, windbreakers or winter jackets. "King County Pet License Canvasser" is printed on the front of the windbreakers, and "Pet Partnership" is printed on the back.

King County Pet Licenses are available at 129 locations throughout King County, including local animal clinics, city halls, and 39 QFC stores. For more information on pet licensing, call 206-296-2712.
