Kenmore Mayor and Deputy Mayor Selected

Kenmore, Wash. – At the City Council meeting on Jan. 14, the Kenmore City Council unanimously selected David Baker to serve as Mayor and Dr. Milton Curtis to serve as Deputy Mayor. These positions are appointed by Kenmore City Councilmembers and each position is a two-year term ending on December 31, 2009. Mayor Baker has served on the City Council for four years and previously held the title of Deputy Mayor.

“I’m honored to be elected as City of Kenmore Mayor and thank my fellow councilmembers for this opportunity,” said Mayor David Baker. “This is an exciting time for the city with the downtown redevelopment project and SR 522 improvement project. I look forward to working with my fellow councilmembers to make decisions that will benefit the Kenmore community.”

Mayor David Baker, Deputy Mayor Milton Curtis, John Hendrickson and Glenn Rogers were sworn in at the Council meeting. All four Councilmembers were elected to City Council in the November 2007 general election. Councilmembers are elected for terms of four years.

The seven-member City Council is the legislative branch of the city government and serves as the policymaking body. The Council is empowered with the authority to enact ordinances and policies and adopt regulations on rates and fees for services provided to the citizens.

City Council study session meetings are held the first and third Mondays of the month at Kenmore City Hall. Regular meetings are held the second and fourth Mondays of the month at Northshore Utility District. Both meetings begin at 7 p.m. unless otherwise posted. Agendas are available by the preceding Friday, but are subject to change up to the time of the meeting.
