## City of Kenmore Snow Update - Road Closure

Kenmore, Wash. – The City of Kenmore public works crews continue to clear snow and ice from roads.

The following is a list of current road closures:

- NE 169th Street between Simonds Road NE & NE 170th Street (local access only)

The following roads have reopened:

- NE 187th Street between 53rd Ave NE & 56th Ave NE

With more snow and freezing temperatures predicted throughout the evening and overnight, roads may close depending on safety concerns. The City of Kenmore public works crews continue to clear snow and ice from roads. Currently, there are three trucks maintaining roads. Two trucks have plows and sanders and one has a plow. During this event, maintenance crews will switch to two 12-hour shifts to ensure 24-hour coverage. The overall goal is to provide the safest driving conditions possible to the public.

Snow and ice crews will focus on primary routes first, including arterials, bus routes, and designated emergency routes. Once the primary routes are open, attention will turn to secondary and residential streets. Crews will continue to work around the clock as long as hazardous street conditions exist.

The City of Kenmore urges citizens to remain off roadways; however, if you must travel, motorists should keep these basic winter driving tips in mind.

- Allow ample time to reach your destination
- Equip your vehicle with all-season tires and carry tire chains
- Dress for weather in case you become stranded and have to walk
- Keep a disaster kit in your vehicle
- Use caution when following a snowplow or sander by allowing at least 100 ft following distance
