Description: Notify vehicles at Vine Church park and ride about the completion of SR 522 sidewalks




Recommended Pedestrian Route

62nd Avenue and Bothell Way



The City of Kenmore has completed construction of new sidewalks and pedestrian crossings on Bothell Way (SR 522). We recommend using the new sidewalks and crossings on 62nd Avenue and Bothell Way to access bus stops from this Park and Ride lot. An alternative route is the sidewalk on the north side of NE 181st Street.



Do not use the south side of NE 181st Street between 61st Avenue and 62nd Avenue for pedestrian access to the bus stops on Bothell Way (SR 522). Walking in the roadway on the south side of NE 181st Street is not safe, especially when it is dark and raining.

In 2017, the City will be constructing additional sidewalk on 62nd Avenue, from the current end of sidewalk, past NE 181st Street.
