

Parking Restrictions

In the case of on-street parking concerns with sight distance and walkways, parking restrictions can be proposed as part of the NTPP. Parking restrictions that are already in force through Washington State law or the Kenmore Municipal Code will not be signed. These are:

- No parking within 30 feet of intersections, 15 feet of fire hydrants, and 5 feet of driveways
- No parking in front of mailboxes between 10:00am and 3:00pm

Parking can also be used strategically on streets with heavy on-street parking volumes to create “virtual” chicanes to slow traffic.

Discussions of shared parking, especially in lots with primary uses only during certain hours or certain days, can be raised as part of the NTPP. The City will facilitate the discussion between citizens and property owners, but the City will not enforce agreements.
